Dear Chief Judge Wolfson:

We represent Defendant Bloomberg L.P. (“Bloomberg”) in the above-referenced action. On July 30, 2019, Bloomberg filed a Motion to Dismiss the Complaint (the “Motion”). (Dkt No. 16.) The following day, the Court entered on the docket a September 3, 2019 deadline for the Motion. Plaintiffs filed an Opposition to the Motion on August 20, 2019. (Dkt. No. 33.)

We write to inform the Court that Bloomberg hereby respectfully withdraws its Motion without prejudice. We kindly request that the Court mark the docket to reflect Bloomberg’s withdrawal and terminate the Motion.

In light of Bloomberg’s withdrawal of the Motion, we respectfully request that the Court set September 6, 2019 as the deadline for Bloomberg to answer the Complaint. There have been no previous requests to extend Bloomberg’s time to answer or otherwise respond to the Complaint.

Plaintiffs have consented to the proposed September 6, 2019 deadline as well as Bloomberg’s withdrawal of the Motion on the condition that Bloomberg consents to this Court’s personal jurisdiction over it. Accordingly, we write to inform the Court that Bloomberg consents to this Court’s personal jurisdiction over it and will not challenge the service of process in this action.
