Before the Court is a Joint Motion to Stay Proceedings Pending Settlement Discussions (the “Motion”). [ECF No. 37.] As outlined in the Motion and corresponding exhibits, the parties stipulated to the tolling of the statute of limitations for putative plaintiffs and ask the Court to stay all proceedings, including all discovery, briefing, and scheduling deadlines. *Id.* The basis of the parties’ agreement and the request in the Motion is a mediation set for August 16, 2021, with Carlos J. Burruezo, Esq. of Burruezo & Burruezo, PLLC. The parties state that if the Court is amenable to the Motion, they will inform the Court of the status of the negotiations by August 16, 2021.

The Court, accordingly, **GRANTS** the Motion, ECF No. 37, and **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

1. The statute of limitations for putative plaintiffs pursuant to the parties’ Tolling Agreement, ECF No. 37-1, is **TOLLED**;
2. All proceedings, including all discovery, briefing, and scheduling deadlines, are hereby **STAYED** until August 16, 2021;

3. The parties are hereby **DIRECTED** to inform the Court of the status of the negotiations by August 16, 2021;
4. At that time, and to the extent necessary, the Court will consider the proposed amended conference and scheduling order, ECF No. 37-2.
